Opportunities for Parents/Guardians to Support Student Academic Achievement

- Grade levels will present "Data Night" information nights to Parents. Kinder – September 1, 1st and 2nd grades – September 2, 3rd, 4th and 5th grades – September 7.
- Teachers will provide frequent informal progress reports to students and families.
- Grades K-5: Mid-Quarter and quarterly grade reports
- Grades 3-5: KAP – English Language Arts and Math achievement reports
- KELPA reports – on an individual basis

- Family Night – December 9, 2021/February 16, 2022 and April 7, 2022
